# Other ideas on how Assembly Representatives could better engage their institutions

Regular social media updates

Create local teams for those connected to UArctic or Arctic research. Regular meetings or online chat groups.

Website; information sessions; engaging students: inclusion / highlighting in research days

Learn more about faculty research, and approach faculty individually when you see opportunities for U Arctic involvement.

Sharing newsletters

Online thematic workshops (e.g., arctic ecology; isolated communities)

Student ambassadors
